NAAPU Indigenous Women Fund is a feminist, indigenous women-led, trust-based funding initiative that places resources directly into the hands of grassroots Indigenous women.

We fund and support:

1. Indigenous women-led organizations
2. Young women-led groups
3. Women with disabilities-led initiatives
4. Informal grassroots collectives in remote communities

NAAPU recognizes indigenous women not as beneficiaries - but as leaders, innovators, and solution builders.
